

Slate Quarrying in and around Maenclochog

The Rosebush quarries





Spoil was tipped to the north-west of the pits (A) to form one large spoilheap which, by 1839 (Maenclochog Tithe Award – above), had encroached on the trackway running north to Bwlch Pennant.

Spoil from the lowest terrace in the Rosebush Quarry was trammed through an adit (B), part in solid rock, part in spoil supported by old tram rails
